

Notice of Intent to Sole Source

The Office of the Comptroller of the Currency (OCC) hereby announces its intent to enter into a sole source contract with LRP Publications, Inc., 360 Hiatt Drive, Palm Beach Gardens, FL 33418, in accordance with FAR 13.106-1(b)(1), only one source is reasonably available, and under authority of Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) Subpart 6.302-1, only one responsible source and no other supplies or services will satisfy agency needs for cyberFEDS eLearning training. The cyberFEDS eLearning training is not offered through the LRP Publication, Inc. GSA Multiple Award Schedule contract. As required by FAR 8.402(f), publicizing and competition requirements have been met. The cyberFEDS eLearning training will be obtained on a sole source basis.

OCC seeks cyberFEDS eLearning training for nine (9) end users. The cyberFEDS eLearning training are self-paced professional development courses. These courses are designed for mandatory or refresher training on core areas and processes involving EEO, employee relations, labor relations, workman's comp and diversity. Without the cyberFEDS eLearning training, the end users will not receive the authoritative guidance and best practices to effectively perform the OCC mission. Furthermore, cyberFEDS eLearning training content is proprietary to LRP Publications and market research indicates that no other vendor is capable of providing the services. The period of performance for this requirement is a base plus four 12-month option year periods.

This notice of intent **is not a request for competitive proposals**. However, any interested party that believes it can meet the cyberFEDS eLearning training requirement described herein may identify themselves and must provide evidence of their capability to fulfill the requirement being requested. **All responses received in writing within three calendar days after date of publication of this notice will be considered by the Government.** Responses must be supported with clear and convincing evidence to clearly be able to provide the services outlined in this notice. A determination by the Government not to compete this proposed contract based upon responses to this notice is solely within the discretion of the Government. A determination by the Government not to compete this requirement based on responses to this notice is solely within the discretion of the Government. Information received will be considered solely for determining whether to conduct a competitive procurement.
